SUMMIT AWARD ENTRY SPECIFICS:

- Submit a Summit Awards Nomination Form and Nominated Project Narrative to Kristin Kim Haynes by 5pm on Thursday, March 19, 2015 via mail, fax, or email.
- All projects must have been COMPLETED between March 1, 2014 and March 1, 2015.
- Companies may submit multiple nominations in multiple categories there is no limit.
- There is no geographic limitation on the location of the nominated project.
- Entries may be used by IECRM for promotional purposes.



SUMMIT AWARDS

SUMMIT AWARD CATEGORIES:

A company may submit more than one nomination, and in more than one category, but must complete a separate Nomination Form (on the back) for each submission.

Residential Construction

- Single Family Residence
- Multi-Family Residence (Including apartment/condominium complexes)

Commercial Construction (Includes office buildings, restaurants, retail facilities, churches, etc.)

- Electrical Contract up to \$500,000
- Electrical Contract between \$500,001 \$1,500,000
- Electrical Contract –\$1,500,001 \$3,000,000
- Electrical Contract greater than \$3,000,000

Industrial Construction (Includes manufacturing facilities, utilities, treatment plants, etc.)

- Electrical Contract up to \$500,000
- Electrical Contract between \$500,001 \$1,500,000
- Electrical Contract –\$1,500,001 \$3,000,000
- Electrical Contract greater than \$3,000,000

Energy Efficiency and Green Construction

- Energy Efficient Retrofit any existing building (residential, commercial, or industrial) that has been completely retrofitted for energy savings
- LEED Certified Project any new project (residential, commercial, or industrial) that followed the USGBC's LEED accreditation program for green building certification
- Renewable Power Generation any project that is net zero energy or positive in generation-toonsite consumption ratio (i.e. wind farm, solar field, or net zero energy building)

Low-Voltage/Limited Energy Systems

Project that exhibits innovation, quality, and overall excellence

SUMMIT AWARD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The Summit Awards Narrative must not exceed ten (10) standard 8.5"x11" pages (excluding the cover page and images), and must address the following four components:

- Project Description and Features Provide a detailed description of the project outlining the scope of work, location, client, and other relevant information. Additionally, describe innovative aspects of the project or programs relating to management, safety, quality control, environmental consideration, green features, scheduling, value engineering, and more.
- 2. **Project Photographs** A minimum of five (5) photographs of the project must be included. Images of any size are allowed. All images must also be submitted on a disk or flash drive.
- 3. **Project Endorsements** Endorsements, references and/or third-party comments should be included. A letter from the owner is recommended.
- 4. **Project Supporting Materials** Relevant supporting materials, such as references, diagrams, marketing and promotional materials, press coverage, and other pertinent information to this project should be included within this section.





SPECIAL PEAK AWARDS

SPECIAL PEAK SUMMIT AWARD CATEGORIES:

A company may submit more than one nomination, and in more than one category, but must complete a separate Nomination Form (on the back) for each submission.

IECRM Electrical Service

 An IECRM member with a service department that exhibits innovation, quality, and overall experience

IECRM Energy Project Manager of the Year

 An electrical or renewable energy Project Manager who has illustrated outstanding performance in the field over the past year

General Contractor (All GCs are nominated by IECRM Members)

- Outstanding General Contractor with annual revenue up to \$25,000,000
- Outstanding General Contractor with annual revenue greater than \$25,000,000

General Contractor Project Manager / Superintendent of the Year

 Nominated by an IECRM Member, this nominee exhibits exceptional project management skills, professionalism, and work ethic

SPECIAL PEAK AWARD APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The Special Peak Award Narrative must not exceed three (3) standard 8.5"x11" pages (excluding the cover page), and must address the following:

For IECRM Electrical Service Award

- 1. Describe what sets apart the company or service department from its competitors.
- 2. Provide supporting materials, such as letters of recommendation, policies, timeliness, etc.

For IECRM Energy Project Manager of the Year Award

- 1. Describe how involved the nominee is in IEC and IECRM (nationally and locally).
- 2. Provide supporting materials, such as letters of recommendation, resumes, etc.

For General Contractor Awards

- 1. Describe how the GC elevates the electrical industry, their community, and IECRM.
- 2. Provide supporting materials, such as a company profile, references, portfolio, etc.

For General Contractor Project Manager / Superintendent of the Year Award

- 1. Describe what you believe motivates the nominee in their daily activities.
- 2. Provide supporting materials, such as letters of recommendation, resume, etc.
